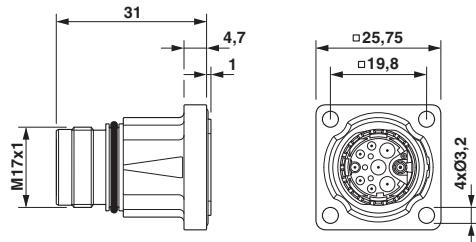

Schematic diagram

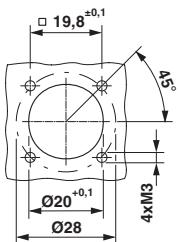


Connector pin assignment
